



## Why use Statewide Contracts?

OSD's Statewide Contracts (SWCs) offer state-negotiated pricing and other tangible benefits, such as prompt pay discounts, bulk purchase pricing, and extended warranties.

## Who may use Statewide Contracts:

Executive Departments are required to use the Operational Services Division's Statewide Contracts for their purchases of goods and services.

Public and quasi-public entities in the commonwealth are eligible to use Statewide Contracts.

Some Statewide Contracts may be open to additional organizations, and some are more restricted in usage.

Below is a complete list of types of organizations generally allowed to use OSD's Statewide Contracts:

- Cities, towns, districts, counties, and other political subdivisions
- Executive, Legislative, and Judicial Branches, including all departments and elected offices therein
- Independent public authorities, commissions, and quasi-public agencies
- Local public libraries, public school districts, and charter schools
- Public hospitals owned by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
- Public institutions of higher education
- Public purchasing cooperatives
- Non-profit, UFR-certified organizations that are doing business with the commonwealth
- Other states and territories with no prior approval by the State Purchasing Agent
- Other entities when designated in writing by the State Purchasing Agent
