Why use Statewide Contracts?

OSD's Statewide Contracts (SWCs) offer state-negotiated pricing and other tangible benefits, such as prompt pay discounts, bulk purchase pricing, and extended warranties This is the Statewide Contract for Public Safety Equipment and Two-Way Radio supplies and services. It replaces and combines the public safety and two-way radio categories from statewide contract numbers FIR04/FIR04A and ITT57. OSD has rebranded the "FIR" and two-way radio statewide contracts to create a brand-new contract category entitled "PSE" to offer a single and cohesive contract for all public safety equipment, supplies and applicable services.

Who may use Statewide Contracts:

Executive Departments are required to use the Operational Services Division's Statewide Contracts for their purchases of goods and services.

Public and quasi-public entities in the commonwealth are eligible to use Statewide Contracts.

Some Statewide Contracts may be open to additional organizations, and some are more restricted in usage.

- Non-profit, UFR-certified organizations that are doing business with the commonwealth
- Other states and territories with no prior approval by the State

- Other entities when designated in writing by the State Purchasing Agent
